Your day will start with a guided tour of Mainz and visit to the impressive sandstone cathedral of the tremendous Old Town.



Set in the breathtaking Rheingau region, the legendary Schloss Johannisberg is steeped in history, cultivating exquisite wine for over 1000 years. The first Riesling winery in the world, at Schloss Johannisberg, discover a unique wine culture and fabled history during this exclusive tour. Set over 124 acres in front of the Taunus mountains, the onsite 300-acre forest grows native oak to make the wooden barrels used for producing the wine. These extraspecial barrels are then kept in the 900 year old abbey cellar, known as "bibliotheca Subterranea", where over 25,000 precious wines are stored. Alternatively, participate in an active hike through the vineyards to the historical Niederwalddenkmal Monument.



Guaranteed Share Program for Single Travelers: If you are traveling alone and would like a roommate for cost savings, let us know at the time of booking your reservation.
