DAILY ITINERARY

DAY 1 - THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 11, 2025

Louisville, Kentucky- Your tour starts in Louisville, Kentucky, famous for Thoroughbreds, Bourbon and baseball. Settle in for a two-night stay at your hotel, ideally situated in downtown Louisville.

DAY 2 -FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 12, 2025

Louisville, Kentucky – Visit Churchill Downs, home of the iconic Kentucky Derby, and tour the Kentucky Derby Museum. Stroll through Old Louisville's Victorian mansions and explore "Museum Row" with your choice of the Louisville Slugger Museum or Frazier Kentucky History Museum. End the day with a welcome dinner at a local restaurant.

DAY 3 - SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 13, 2025

Louisville/Lexington – Tour Buffalo Trace, America's oldest operating bourbon distillery, and enjoy a tasting. Stop in the historic town of Midway before exploring Kentucky's horse country with a local guide. Visit private horse farms amid rolling bluegrass landscapes, then settle into Lexington for a two-night stay.

DAY 4 - SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 14, 2025

Lexington/Berea/Lexington – Visit Berea, Kentucky's Folk Arts and Crafts Capital, to meet local artisans at work. Explore the Kentucky Music Hall of Fame, then enjoy a taste of Kentucky cuisine at a local restaurant.

DAY 5 - MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 15, 2025

Lexington – Gatlinburg, Tennessee – Start the day at Kentucky's GLASS National Art Museum to explore contemporary glass art. Travel through Daniel Boone National Forest before arriving in Gatlinburg, the gateway to the Great Smoky Mountains. Enjoy the rest of the day exploring downtown or visiting attractions like Dollywood.

DAY 6 - TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 16, 2025

Great Smoky Mountains National Park – Gatlinburg – Explore the park with a local guide, stopping at lookouts and Newfound Gap for stunning views. Enjoy a picnic before visiting Cherokee's Qualla arts cooperative. End the day with a tour and tasting at Ole Smoky Moonshine Distillery.

DAY 7 - WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 17, 2025

Gatlinburg/Asheville, North Carolina – Travel to Asheville in the Blue Ridge Mountains for a two-night stay. Spend the afternoon and evening exploring the city's craft breweries, chocolate shops, and farm-to-table dining.

DAY 8 - THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 18, 2025

Asheville – Visit the Biltmore Estate, built in 1895 by George Vanderbilt II as his mountain retreat. Tour the grand mansion and its beautiful grounds. End the day with a farewell dinner at a local restaurant.

DAY 9 - FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 19, 2025

Asheville/Charlotte/Tour Ends – Your tour ends today. As you head home, carry with you the spirit and warmth of America's Southeast.
